

Volunteer Facilitator Job Description

Purpose of the Position:

To create an environment of safety and compassionate support for children and teens who are grieving. Facilitators provide support, offer structured and unstructured activities, and encourage group sharing.

Qualifications:

- 1. Ability to commit to attending each Rick's Place session (2x month) for a year.
- 2. Flexibility coupled with the ability to set boundaries, maintain group rules, and follow the child's lead where appropriate.
- 3. Consistent, caring, warm approachable presence, with the ability to address feelings related to the issues of death, dying, and bereavement.
- 4. Willingness to collaborate and share group facilitation duties.
- 5. Must be available Monday and/or Tuesday evenings for groups.

Scope of Work:

- 1. Actively participate in training and supervision meetings including the initial 9-hour volunteer training, pre- and post- meetings and periodic volunteer meetings as scheduled.
- 2. Facilitate a group of children/teens in a planned activity, including processing of emotions.
- 3. Manage group dynamics according to the shared agreements created by each group.
- 4. Help with various tasks related to group activities as assigned by the Program Manager or Director.
- 5. Maintain professional boundaries and confidentiality with participants currently receiving services at Rick's Place.
